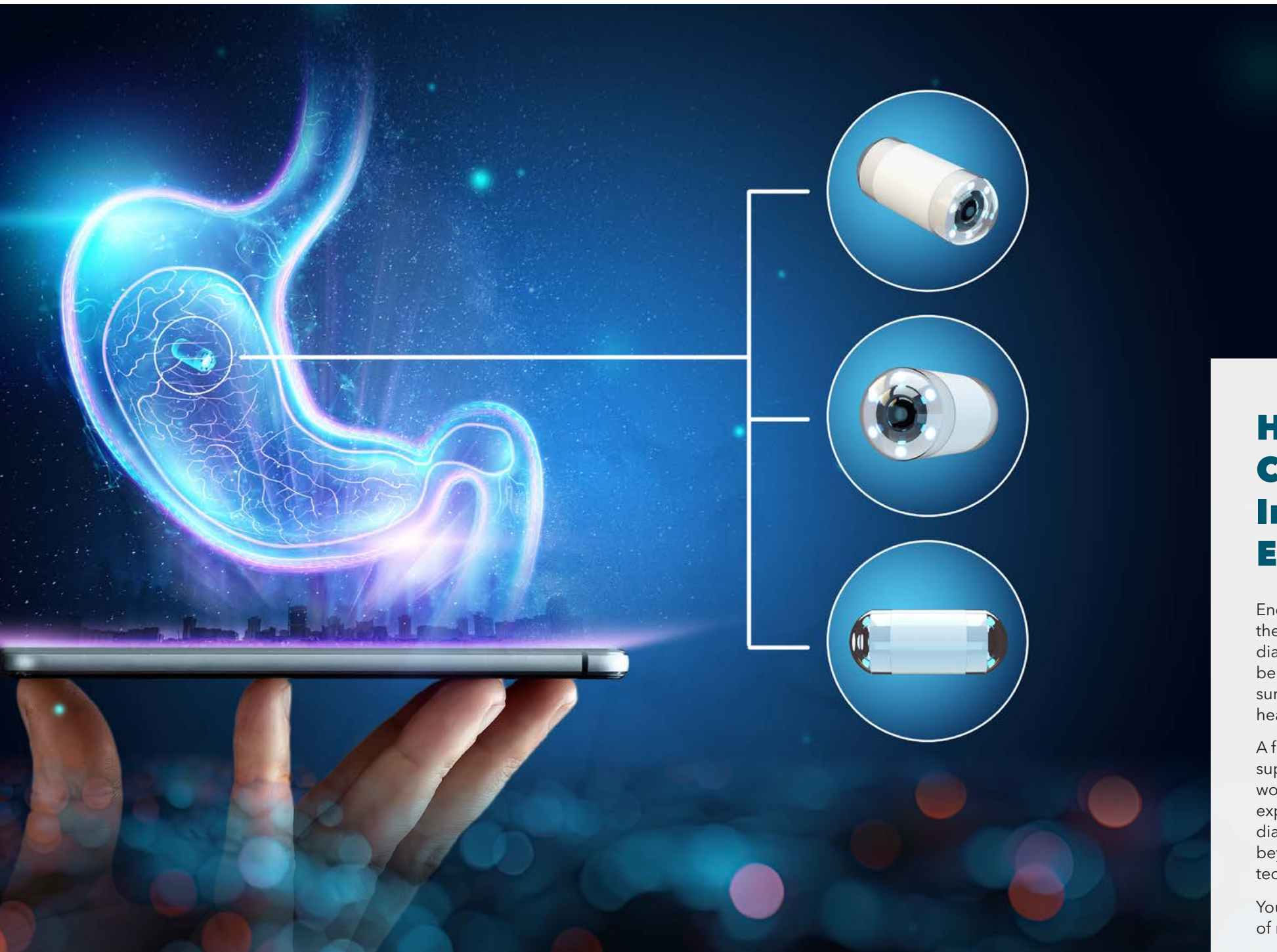



## Tomorrow. Tomorrow I'll finally get some answers.

For more than six years, Allie Peterson desperately sought an answer for her puzzling combination of symptoms... fatigue, headaches and fainting spells that worsened with each passing month. Every doctor she saw came to the same conclusion: "you're overreacting." But to Allie, it was all frighteningly real.

Now she was placing her life in the hands of Dr. Amar Thosani.



"They made it seem like it was all in my head," Allie recalls. "Like if they couldn't diagnose it, it wasn't real."

Allie, an active 16-year-old student, woke up one day feeling uncharacteristically lethargic. First extreme fatigue, then debilitating headaches and pain on her right side. When she started fainting regularly, Allie's mom Diane insisted she see a doctor.

Allie is tall and lean. The doctor concluded she could have an eating disorder. It wouldn't be the last time a doctor missed the signs.

"Every time we went to a doctor, I was 'written off,'" Allie recalls. Each one had a new idea: perhaps mono or an autoimmune disease or even an eating disorder.

Allie bravely lived her life under this cloud, her "new normal," and boldly moved to New York City to attend college. But the cloud followed her. By age 22, Allie was missing wide swaths of her day, confused as to what she had been doing or how she got where she was. This forced her give up school, work and her independence.

Desperate for answers, Diane found a neurologist, who believed Allie had likely been experiencing seizures and sent her to the emergency room immediately. They sat in Mayo's emergency waiting room for five hours, as Allie experienced seizure after seizure. Diane begged the nurses to see her daughter and when they did, they discovered her blood sugar had plummeted to a dangerously low level, inducing shock.

A team of 15 Mayo doctor and nurses worked to save her life. But once her blood sugar stabilized and Allie was conscious again they sent her home.

Through the next months, Diane monitored Allie's blood sugar and

continued looking for answers. Seeing a new endocrinologist, Diane presented her notebook detailing Allie's symptoms, diagnoses and treatments over the past six years. This time, the doctor immediately made a call to his trusted colleague.

In less than a week, Allie sat in front of HonorHealth's Dr. Amar Thosani, an interventional gastroenterologist with a special interest in pancreatic diseases. He performed an endoscopy, which confirmed a slow growing, cancerous neuroendocrine tumor at the top of Allie's pancreas.

"I'm so relieved!" Allie exclaimed. Dr. Thosani had to chuckle, as most of his patients wouldn't respond to a cancer diagnosis with such enthusiasm.

Allie's condition was very unusual in a patient so young. The standard of care for this diagnosis was the Whipple Procedure, but Dr. Thosani had reservations about performing the invasive, risky, life-altering surgery on such a young patient.

Dr. Thosani rallied his HonorHealth team to consider a less-invasive, interventional option. He knew he could use the endoscope to reach her pancreas. He had prior success performing a radiofrequency ablation, essentially burning the tumor away.

He shared this new plan with Allie and her family, and it sounded like the miracle they had been seeking. The only problem was, there was no appropriate ablation device in the region. Using his vast network, Dr. Thosani had a special scope flown to HonorHealth, while Allie had a hard time sleeping that night, hoping against six years of hope that this was her answer.

### Six years and one day.

Allie arrived at the HonorHealth Center for Interventional Endoscopy, eager to get the procedure done. As with most endoscopies, she was able to go home the same day.

“Literally overnight, my life changed for the better!”

And Allie has grabbed every opportunity that interventional endoscopy offered her. She finished her degree last year and moved to California for a new job. She enjoys Pilates

and other activities she gave up for so many years. She and her boyfriend got a new puppy. And she has started volunteering with healthcare organizations to help others going through a difficult journey.

Allie credits her mom’s persistence and Dr. Thosani and his team for giving her such an innovative option.

“They all worked really hard to find answers to my difficult case. His kindness and compassion saved my life. I am so blessed that they went the extra mile.”

## Visionary Leadership

Through the generosity of Foundation supporters, the **Center for Interventional Endoscopy** expanded in 2023, with three subspecialists offering the highest level of expertise in the region.

To support the program’s growing number of patients, the program will expand to treat complex cases in the HonorHealth Piper Surgery Center, 2nd floor.

HonorHealth Research Institute has evolved into the pre-eminent regional multi-pronged powerhouse of early phase clinical research and care.

## HonorHealth Research Institute and HonorHealth Heart Care



Contributions from all corners of our community helped fund construction to create one of the leading destinations for comprehensive heart care in the country. As the HonorHealth cardiovascular team partners with the Research Institute, they are advancing new technologies and treatment options:

**ACUTUS heart mapping**, a highly specialized device pinpoints the source of atrial fibrillation for precise intervention.

**J-Valve for aortic regurgitation**, an alternative to open-heart surgery for leaky aortic valve. HonorHealth was one of only two hospitals in the country to introduce the procedure.

**Dual chamber leadless pacemaker** helps patients with abnormal or slow heart rhythms. A traditional pacemaker is implanted on the chest wall and connected to the heart by wires. This new system is a much smaller, self-contained unit that automatically delivers an electrical pulse when needed.

**AI-powered heart imaging**, an ultrasound imaging console based on next generation acoustic technologies that enable never-before-seen detail during examinations. The system’s AI software uses advanced algorithms and an expert database of real clinical cases to recognize anatomical patterns and perform automated measurements.

## New Options for Heart Patients

Your generosity in 2023 fueled innovative breakthroughs, enabling HonorHealth Research Institute to deploy promising new technologies and techniques – often for the first time in the world – to provide patients with remarkable opportunities for longer, high-quality survival. A growing number of these patients suffer from complex heart conditions.

High-tech is at the heart of HonorHealth Heart Care but the high cost of acquiring a special technology that may only be used by a few patients each year prevents many hospitals from making the investment.

In the final year of a three-year, \$45 million Foundation campaign to support the expansion of HonorHealth Heart Care’s cardiovascular center of excellence, HonorHealth proved why philanthropic support for cardiovascular care and research are good investments.

## Innovative Technology Has Patient Feeling Like New

For more than a year, Marie had been putting off heart surgery. Her leaky aortic valve made her tired and short of breath. Left untreated, she would very likely suffer a heart attack.

The thought of open-heart surgery held her back – but not out of fear for her own well-being. As the primary caregiver for her husband, who suffered permanent disability from stroke, she needed to be strong and at her best.

“The aortic valve is the front door of your heart,” explains David Rizik, MD, chief, complex interventional cardiology (above and below left). “Every drop of blood in your body has to go through the aortic valve.” Marie’s aortic valve could not close tightly, allowing blood to leak backward into the left ventricle with each heartbeat, a condition called aortic regurgitation. The condition forces the heart to work harder to pump blood with every beat, leading to an enlarged heart and eventually, heart failure.

Previously, the only treatment for aortic regurgitation was open-heart surgery. But Dr. Rizik had been studying a non-surgical, catheter-based technique to treat patients like Marie, who are not good surgical candidates for open heart surgery. The experimental J-Valve seemed to be the perfect option.



In this procedure, the J-Valve is delivered via catheter through the leg. Once in place, the patch is clipped over the leaky valve. The procedure requires four hands in perfect coordination. Dr. Rizik was joined by Dr. Robert Riley, chief, complex cardiovascular surgery (below, right).

“She trusted us,” says Dr. Rizik admiringly. “Marie was one of the first in the country to undergo this procedure and one of only a handful in the world.”

And Marie is so glad she did.

“I was out of the hospital in less than two days and back home with no pain. In just a couple of months, I was back to running three miles every morning, no more shortness of breath. It was a miracle!”



HonorHealth is already sharpening the cutting edge of new treatments and technologies, but a renowned center of excellence requires continued investment in expertise, infrastructure, services and technology.



HonorHealth Heart Care will open the first phase of its new center of excellence in late 2024.

## Valley couple pays it forward with gift to the Greatest Needs Fund

Rocky and Virginia Saunders have an enthusiasm for life and an attitude of gratitude that runs deep through their hearts. Gratitude for friends, for health and for the ability to give back.

With careers that took them to live in California, Washington and New York, they decided to return and retire to the Valley in 2008. In a bittersweet experience, Rocky became acquainted with HonorHealth by way of medical necessity. However, that experience helped nurture an 11-year partnership as a volunteer at HonorHealth Scottsdale Thompson Peak Medical Center.

"I take care of the front desk and work with a lot of people coming into the hospital to answer all their questions and any concerns about navigating their experience there," explains Rocky. "I love it. Virginia and I have also made great friendships through my time at Thompson Peak."

Recently, Virginia and Rocky also became donors with an inspirational gift to the Greatest Needs Fund, which helps HonorHealth respond quickly to urgent needs and take advantage of new opportunities.

"So many people donate to specific areas, but our vision was to make it possible for the hospital to use the money where it is urgently needed," explains Virginia. "We wanted our impact to be where it is needed most, in the moment, even if that isn't always the most glamorous."

As a volunteer, Rocky sees what the staff does for patients every day, as well as the warm and special culture there. This reinforced their decision to support the Greatest Needs Fund.

"You truly feel cared for at HonorHealth, and it's apparent the staff working with you really want you to heal and get better," Virginia says. "And that is so important to the patient – to know they are invested in their health."



## BLUE ZONES: A MODEL TO LIVE LONGER, HEALTHIER LIVES

In collaboration with the city of Scottsdale, HonorHealth announced a sweeping initiative to improve health outcomes, reduce healthcare costs and create overall greater well-being in our community.

The Blue Zones Scottsdale Project involves the entire community working together toward one common goal – to transform the environments where people live, work, learn and play to measurably improve community well-being, resilience and economic vitality.

What is Blue Zones? In 2004, founder Dan Buettner teamed with National Geographic, the National Institute on Aging and the world's leading longevity researchers to identify pockets around the world where people lived measurably better, longer lives. Insights from that study provided a model for sustainable, long-term environmental changes that strengthen social ties, enhance surroundings and sharpen living policies.

In 2023, the city of Scottsdale underwent an assessment that showed us the potential for working together toward this vision:

- \$183.6M in projected medical costs savings
- \$318.3M reduction in lost workforce productivity
- \$226 average per capita medical savings in our adult population
- \$104.5M in direct and indirect benefits to the regional economy

The Blue Zones Scottsdale Project aligns with HonorHealth's commitment to be more than a hospital – to influence and improve overall well-being for our community. We are grateful to our partners in this vision and for your support of this multi-year effort.

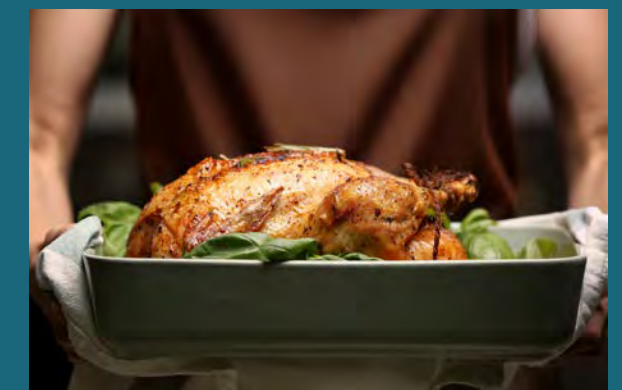

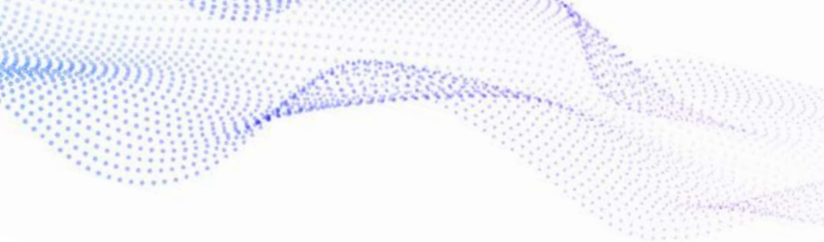

HonorHealth is the only community hospital in the nation to provide realistic, high-quality trauma medical training to all branches of the military, active duty, National Guard and Reserves, as well as first responders. With the support of our community, this training is offered at no charge.

Training these dedicated service members can dramatically improve the chances of survival for those seriously injured on the battlefield or even in our community. To provide this level of expertise, the Military Partnership’s training features:

- Advanced practical learning with high-tech, life-like human patient simulators
- Real-life experience during clinical rotations, including the Level I Trauma Center at HonorHealth Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center
- 10-week nurse transition program and critical care/emergency trauma nursing fellowship

## Sports Medicine training saves high school senior

For a brief moment after a player collapsed during football practice at Scottsdale's Coronado High School, everyone froze in shocked silence.

But in mere moments, the coaching staff applied the emergency training they learned from Tessa Powell, HonorHealth's Head Athletic Trainer assigned to the school.

Coaches quickly confirmed the student was in cardiac arrest and started CPR. Others called 9-1-1.

They did everything right. But without an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) on the field or even nearby, the responsibility for keeping the student alive through CPR fell to the coaches.

HonorHealth is leading an initiative to improve AED accessibility in schools, starting with the Scottsdale Unified School District. Your support can make a significant impact on our ability to provide these life-saving devices to ensure a swift response to these increasing life-threatening situations on our children's sports fields.

This story has a happy ending. EMS crews arrived quickly and took over. Doctors diagnosed an underlying heart condition, which the student athlete is now managing.

## A nurse's special care touches three family members

"My brother unexpectedly passed away in your ICU at Shea. He was a big-hearted man and one of my best friends. I often think through his final days and hope that I told him enough times how much I love him, and did what I could to help his passing.

We were incredibly fortunate to have John R. as our ICU nurse. I was so distraught, so confused and so afraid of making a bad decision for my brother. John was always steady, patient, constantly monitoring my brother while compassionately guiding us through what was ultimately going to end with my brother's death.

The other part of our story is that my mother is a heart failure patient and was admitted a few days before my brother. It was so surreal when I had to walk from my brother's room in the ICU to mom's room to tell her that her son was down the hall and not going to survive. John R. was incredibly gentle and kind to my mother. She visited my brother several times and we held his hand when he passed. The next morning Mom told me that John R. had visited, sitting with her a bit, telling mom that he did everything he could for my brother.

I am sure he knows how important his exceptional nursing skills are, but how he touched our lives as a person is the motivation behind me writing you. His hard work and dedication to my brother was admirable, the strength and steadfast reassurance he gave to me was exactly what I needed, and the compassion and kindness he showed to my mother still brings me to tears.

It has been almost 6 months now and I still do not have enough words to thank John for what he did for me and my family. I can simply say thank you, I will forever be grateful, and I will remember you always."

With this grant, HonorHealth was able to purchase three new Giraffe OmniBeds for the NICU. These beds feature advanced technology to help infants maintain their temperature, reduce risk of infection, allow families to interact with their baby and give care providers faster, easier access to the baby. They serve as a surrogate womb until the infant can be placed in a crib.

This heartfelt gift is expected to serve more than 250 tiny newborns, giving them a safer start in life.

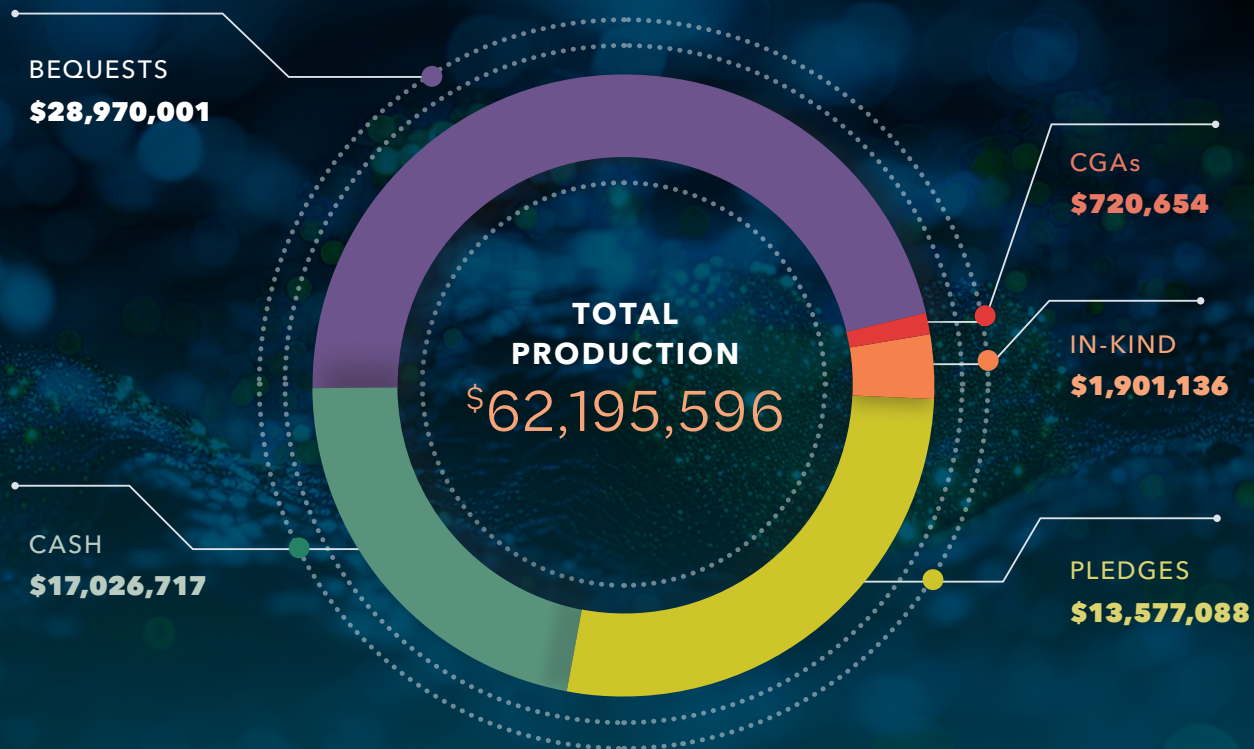

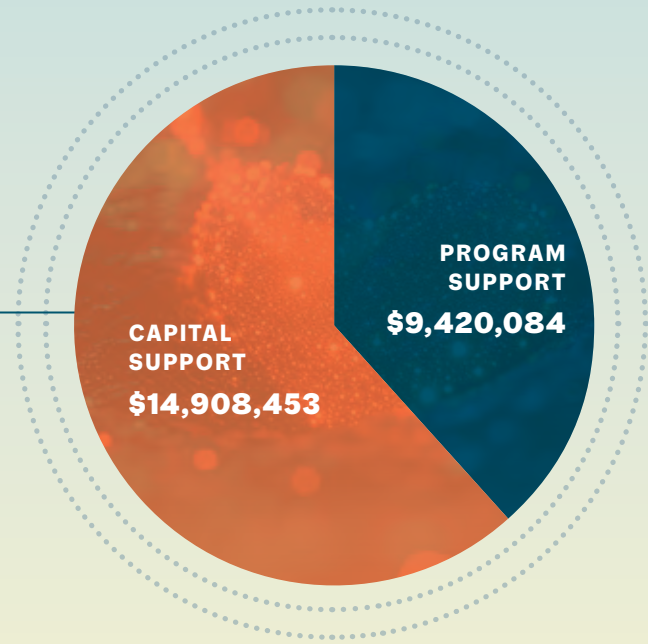

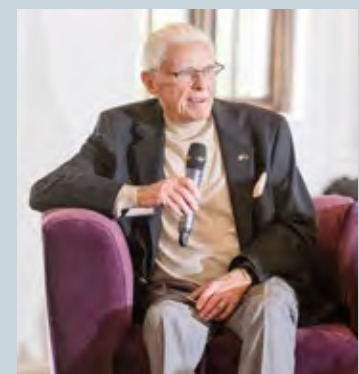
