

Tournament Play Format

Tournament play will be morning or afternoon shotgun start in a Shamble format - the team will scramble to the best drive, then each player will play out his/her own ball through the hole. Each team is composed of an amateur foursome and a professional.

The field will be flighted by team handicap. All teams will be handicapped at 10% of the total handicap of the four amateur participants. All handicaps must be verified before the first ball is struck in the round. Southwest Section PGA staff will serve as rules officials and scorers for the event. SWSPGA also will monitor pace of play to ensure an enjoyable time by all.

HonorHealth Desert Mission traces its roots to 1927, a time when it brought food and medical supplies to people who camped north of Phoenix city limits, hoping the dry desert air would cure their respiratory ailments.

Desert Mission Food Bank

Over the past two years, we've had to find new ways to assist the hungry. With the 4th Street Market closed for in-store shopping, we created a touchless drive-through grocery, loading bags of fresh, nutritious food into car trunks. A mobile market delivered food to seniors, low-income area schools and frontline healthcare workers in need.

Lincoln Learning Center

One of the few Arizona schools to meet the nation's highest standards for child development and school readiness, this licensed, accredited childcare and early education program gives young kids the educational environment they need to be fully prepared for kindergarten and beyond.

Adult Day Healthcare

This center offers a safe environment and enriching activities for older adults, as well as a respite for their caregivers. Participants range in age from 56 to 100, most of whom have dementia, Alzheimer's or other cognitive disorders.
