

IN 2022, GENEROUS DONORS LIKE YOU ENABLED DESERT MISSION TO PROVIDE:

16,585 emergency food boxes

8,334 households with food (Individuals and households were counted only once but may have been served multiple times)

3,296 federally funded emergency food boxes, supplemented with items from the food bank, for low-income seniors

272 children with an accredited childcare and early education program at Lincoln Learning Center with 97 percent of pre-K graduates assessed as Kindergarten-ready

A safe environment and beneficial activities for older adults at Adult Day Healthcare, 25 percent of whom are veterans, with the oldest enjoying each day at 97 years old
